Dear Mr. Kettner:

I am in receipt of your Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. §552 et seq. ("FOIA"), appeal dated May 15, 1995 and received by the Legal Services Corporation ("LSC" or "Corporation") on May 18, 1995. Your FOIA request was for any records in the possession of the Corporation which pertain to LSC's decision that Ozark Legal Services ("OLS") did not violate the LSC Act or regulations in declining to represent you. You are appealing LSC's determination that LSC possessed no records responsive to your FOIA request, other than those records you provided to us or records that had already been forwarded to you by LSC.

I have reviewed the file and determined that the Corporation's request to OLS dated June 27, 1994, for information regarding your complaint and OLS' response dated July 13, 1994, may not previously have been sent to you. Therefore, out of an abundance of caution, I am enclosing those pages in the event that you do not already have the materials in your possession. I am confident, with your receipt of these materials, that you have copies of all LSC records in this matter.


